- Development of reading and phonics progression pathway from P1-3

- P1-3 staff will participate in Maths Recovery programme
- Staff will review and develop resources for teaching number within the class
- Implementation of SLC progression planners
- Peer visits/professional dialogue to allow staff to share good practice and evaluate learning within numeracy
