

PRIMARY 4: TERM 3 2024

Reading:

This term, the children will be encouraged to read as widely as possible, in class and at home, and to make use of the class library to extend their range of texts. During class reading sessions the children will be encouraged to:

- identify and consider the purpose and main ideas of a text;
- read for pleasure;
- contribute to class /group discussions;
- Use contents, index, headings, sub-headings and diagrams to help locate information;

Writing:

The children will look at a range of writing genres, including descriptions, non-chronological reports and story writing. Throughout the term, they should read interesting texts to inspire high quality writing. Please encourage your child to read at home as much as possible in order to support their class learning. During class writing lessons the children will be learning to:

- use appropriate punctuation and order and link sentences;
- organise notes under headings;
- use a dictionary and thesaurus;
- proof-read their writing.

Numeracy:

It is important that your child can quickly recall their multiplication facts. The children will continue to revise their knowledge of multiplication tables through daily practice in class, supported by homework activities. Please encourage your child to practise their multiplication tables at home.

In addition the children will learn to:

- recognise hundreds, tens and units in numbers;
- understand and describe place value of any number to 1000;
- make 3 digit numbers recording in numbers and words;
- describe, plot and use two-figure grid references.
