



## **Literacy**

In Literacy and English, this term Primary 6 will be focusing on:

### Reading

- Novel Study - Wonder
- Identifying the main idea in texts
- Summarising and concluding
- Figurative Language
- Comprehension questions – locating the information from the text.
- Reading a variety of genres for enjoyment
- Extending our knowledge of Scots language
- Making notes based on texts they have read, watched or listened to – creating appropriate subheadings
- Keeping a journal of the books we have read and our reviews of them

### Writing

- Talk for Writing Zelda Claw – defeating the monster story
- Focusing on suspense
- Poetry – structures of different types of poetry with Scottish links.
- Information Texts
- Confidently using IT to publish and display work
- Reading over and editing our writing to ensure it makes sense

## **Numeracy**

In Numeracy this term, we will be focusing on and revising:

- Comparing and ordering fractions with different denominators.
- Addition and subtraction involving halves and quarters
- Simplifying fractions
- Finding a fraction of a set/quantity
- Concept of percentages
- Language and notation of percentages
- Time – 12 and 34 hour notation.
- Time duration
- Negative, square and cubed numbers
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## **Religious Education**

In RE this term we will be focusing on:

- Christian Unity
- Lent
- Mass Responses

## **Health and Wellbeing**

In Health and Wellbeing, we will be focusing on kindness, friendship vs popularity, points of view and empathy. All themes that link into Wonder (class novel).

## **Across the Curriculum**

In Social Subjects we will be learning about The Titanic:

- Primary and secondary sources selectively to research events in the past.
- Compare a society in the past with my own and contribute to a discussion of the similarities and differences.
- Gather and use information about forms of discrimination against people in societies and consider the impact this has on people's lives.

In Science we will be focusing on Water Cycle:

- How water changes state to help me understand the processes involved in the water cycle in nature over time.
