Literacy

The greatest importance this term will be on identifying common words. Your child will be learning to find evidence from the text to answer comprehension style questions. They will be developing the use of their voice to add expression when reading aloud by beginning to use punctuation to help read with expression.

Numeracy

In numeracy this term there will be a focus on multiplication and division. They will be able to make, count and describe multiplication and division as groupings, arrays, jumps, sharing and repeated addition and subtraction. They will also be exploring time, using o'clock, half past and am and pm.

Religious Education

This term your child will be learning about participating in Mass and the symbols and rituals in worship. As we move into the season of Lent and Eastertide they will learn about forgiveness and reconciliation in preparation for the season of Easter. They will also learn about the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus, and eternal life.

Social Subjects

Our topic this term will be Fairyland. Your child will explore many traditional fairytales and cross curricular areas throughout this topic as we recreate and transform the infant department into Fairyland.

Health & Wellbeing

PE sessions are on a Tuesday and Thursday. PE sessions will cover Yoga and Athletics.

A homework table has been put into the homework jotter. The homework format will be the same every week, therefore please refer to this table every week for homework tasks. Please read every night with your child, even if it seems repetitive as this builds confidence the more your child becomes familiar with the story. Please practice the common words sheet every night.
