Literacy

Reading

- Focus on Non- Fiction texts
- Opportunities to read texts on a variety of subject areas and decide on favourites
- Visit to St Leonard's library with focus on sourcing and locating non-fiction texts
- Continue to develop fluency and expression, using punctuation, when reading aloud
- Opportunities for children to select texts for personal reading in class, from the school library and at home
- Continue to develop definitions and spelling of unfamiliar vocabulary
- Develop a variety of question and answer techniques to show understanding of texts read
- Opportunities to share facts learned with peers

Writing / Talking and Listening

- Non-Fiction writing focus
- Developing skills in writing an advert and a persuasive text
- Using imperative and modal verbs
- Promoting a view to influence the reader or listener
- Persuade a friend game
- Turning negatives to positives to use in persuasion

Numeracy

- Accurate recall of all times tables continues to be a focus
- Addition and subtraction of number bonds to 100 and beyond will be regularly revisited, and should continue to be revised at home
- Place value – writing number up to and beyond a million, including numbers to 3 decimal places, in digits and words.
- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of numbers up to, and beyond, 4 digits
- We will be learning to read a variety of scales correctly
