Literacy

Reading

- We are reading a whole class novel 'The Final Year' by Matt Goodfellow, which is written in verse. We will be completing a range of before, during and after activities to develop reading skills and comprehension skills. We will also be using the emotional experiences discussed to assist us in preparing for High School.
- There will be opportunities for children to select texts for personal reading in class, from the school library and at home
- We will continue to develop understanding of definitions and spelling of unfamiliar vocabulary from weekly spelling words and a variety of texts
- Develop a variety of question and answer techniques to show understanding of texts read

Writing

- We will be focusing on using punctuation and grammar correctly in all pieces of writing
- We will be developing skills in checking our spelling by using technology for spell checks.
- We will continue to develop proof reading of writing, checking for and correcting mistakes – grammar and spelling.

Talking and Listening

- Continue to develop ability to ask and answer literal and inferential questions appropriately
- Devise own questions appropriate to subject area
- Respect the contribution of other children during discussions

Numeracy

- Children will be identifying and describing angles, by name and size
- They will be measuring and drawing angles accurately, using a protractor
- Children will be learning to use directional compass points
- We will be interpreting data from a variety of different displays.

Religious Education

Our focus will be on Confirmation preparation and on organising our Leaver's mass.

Social Subjects/Interdisciplinary learning

We are learning about People, Place and environment and linking this with numeracy and maths, in particular reading and interpreting maps.

Health & Wellbeing

Children will be learning about changes that will take place in their bodies during puberty and the importance of personal hygiene.
